- 100 Topic cards (200 TOPICS)
- 48 Player cards
- 48 Point cards

1- Setup

- Shuffle all the **Topic** cards ① to form a deck and place it in the center of table.
- Place the **Point** cards ② nearby.
- Each player chooses their favorite deck of **Player** cards ③.
- Return any unused **Player** cards to the box.

The player who most recently celebrated their birthday is the first **Player of Honour**. The other players become the **Guessers** for the round.

The **Player of Honour** draws 5 **Topic** cards and places them side by side on the table

2- Round Overview

The **Guessers** try to guess the exact order of the Player of Honour's preferences from the most-liked (1) to the least-liked (5).



They place their **Player** cards **face down** next to the corresponding **Topic** cards.

Marie, Eric, and Simon are the **Guessers**, and must try to guess the order of Sarah's preferences by placing their **Player** cards next to the corresponding **Topic** cards.

• **I Know This One!** card:



The **Guessers** have to place their **I Know This One!** card on the Player card they are the most sure of.

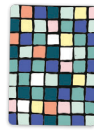
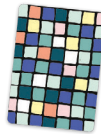
→ (Yup, you have to, even if you're not sure!)

→ Be careful not to place your #1 or #5 **Player** cards first, this could influence the other players.

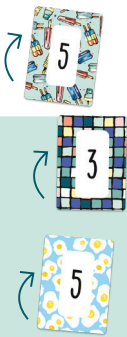


3- Reveal and Score

The **Player of Honour** places and reveals their #5 **Player** card next to the **Topic** card they like the least.



Every **Guesser** reveals their **Player** card next to that **Topic** card and counts their points.



- Every **Guesser** scores **1 point** for every one of their **Player** cards with the same number as the **Player of Honour's**.
- The **I Know This One!** card gives **1 bonus point** for a correct answer.

When all the **Player** cards are revealed, the **Player of Honour** can count their points. They earn the same amount of points as the **Guesser** who earned the most points that round.



The players then repeat these actions in descending order.



Every **Guesser** who got everything right gets **1 bonus point** and gives the **Player of Honour** a high five!

- For example:



Marie had two correct answers, but her **I Know This One!** card didn't earn her any points.
→ She gets **2 points**.



Eric had 3 correct answers and **1 bonus point** for his **I Know This One!** card.
→ He gets **4 points**.

Simon managed to get all of Sarah's preferences right! As a result, he gets **5 points** for his 5 correct answers, **1 bonus point** for his **I Know This One!** card, and **1 bonus point** and a high five from Sarah for his 5 correct answers.
→ He gets **7 points**.

Sarah gets the same number of points as the best **Guesser**, so she gets **7 points** too!

4 - End of Turn

The player seated next to the **Player of Honour** becomes the new **Player of Honour**. Place 5 new **Topic** cards from the deck onto the table. Repeat the previous steps until every player has been the **Player of Honour** twice (with 4 or fewer players) or once (with 5 or more players).



- "Duo" Variant (2 players)



In this 2-player variant, there are no **Guessers**. Both players are **Players of Honour** and place their **Player** cards in the order of their own preferences. They will not use their **I Know This One!** card.

Both players then reveal their **Player** cards and score **1 point** for every matching answer. The game ends after 10 rounds, with **50 points** being a perfect score.

→ But it would be kind of freaky, right...? **15 points** is already a pretty darn good score!
